

LPIB Modern Slavery Statement for Website

Modern slavery is a crime and a violation of fundamental human rights. It takes various forms, such as slavery, servitude, forced and compulsory labour and human trafficking, all of which have in common the deprivation of a person's liberty by another in order to exploit them for personal or commercial gain. We are committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business dealings and relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure modern slavery is not taking place anywhere in our own business or in any of our supply chains.

As an insurance intermediary, LP does not operate in a sector where modern slavery is prevalent and, as a Company, we have not identified any modern slavery concerns.

We are committed to ensuring there is transparency in our own business and in our approach to tackling modern slavery throughout our supply chains, consistent with our disclosure obligations under the Modern Slavery Act 2015. We expect the same high standards from all of our contractors, suppliers and other business partners and, as part of our contracting processes, we include specific prohibitions against the use of forced, compulsory or trafficked labour, or anyone held in slavery or servitude, whether adults or children, and we expect that our suppliers will hold their own suppliers to the same high standards.

The Board of LP provides strong and effective leadership across all aspects of the business, with a commitment to raising staff awareness on modern slavery. Relevant training and robust policies are in place, in order to advise and assist the staff, such as Modern Slavery, Anti Bribery & Corruption, Complaints, Equal Opportunities & Diversity and Whistleblowing – all of which can be found on the LP Intranet. All policies are updated on an ad hoc basis and reviewed annually, to ensure compliance.
